# **Showjumping Ireland Summer Series**

# **Important Information.**

### **RULES FOR HORSES AND RIDERS**

- 1. Open to all Showjumping Ireland Registered Riders & Horses, no Temporary Registrations accepted for qualification or at the Grand Final. Shows must be registered & competitors will jump under SJI Rules. All ages & passports are welcome to compete.
- 2. Minimum of THREE Show appearances on the Tour qualifies you to enter for the Grand Final Weekend
- 3. All Horse and Rider combinations must be pre-entered for the Grand Finals & the rider that rode it on the THREE qualifying shows on the series is the rider eligible to ride it on the Grand Final Weekend.
- 4. A rider can ride a maximum of 4 horse/class in the Grand Final Qualifiers & a Maximum of 2 horses in a the Final.
- 5. Horse and Rider combination may compete in TWO height band Qualifiers/horse at the Grand Finals weekend.
- 6. A rider/horse combination may compete in Two Grand Finals.
- 7. If a rider has more than 2 horses qualified for any of the Finals it is the highest placed horses on the Result Sheets that will go forward to the Finals.
- 8. There will be a leading rider prize in each section for the horse and rider combination who has accumulated the most points throughout the Summer Series.
- 9. There will be a prize fund of €1,000 for the leading rider in each section (90cm,1 metre, 110cm and 120cm)
- 10. Points will follow SJI Points and the leaderboard will be available on SJI Live



11. Classes in the Summer Series are 90cm, 1 metre, 110cm, and 120cm

12. All qualifiers must be standalone classes and second round against the clock.

## Classes can be run as two phase modified timed. Article Number 278.8N

- 13. Rugs and rosettes to the Winner at each qualifier.
- 14. Minimum Prize find at qualifiers €150.00

## **Grand Final:**

- The Grand Final will be held in Mullingar Equestrian Centre on the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> of September.
- There will be one qualifier on Saturday for eligible horse and rider combinations (3 appearances throughout the Summer Series) and the top 30 will go through to the Grand Final on Sunday.
- Prize fund of €2,000 in each Grand Final.
- There will be a consolation final for all of those who have not qualified for the Grand Final on Sunday.

All standard SJI Protocols will stand for in relation to Veterinary Checks, Stipendiary Stewarding, boots, Warm Up arena fence height & warm up practices etc.

Unsportsmanlike behaviour will be dealt with by the Stipendiary Stewards & the Ground Jury

Please note that it is the responsibility of the agent/owner/rider to keep a record of their points.

All queries must be dealt with by email before the final leg of the tour. No queries regarding leader boards will be dealt with at the final leg.

- Teams will be selected by the Showjumping Ireland Office
- Each team will have 4 riders.
- \*\* 4 Riders on each team from any height category (combinations must have competed at THREE Summer Series shows.
- \*\*Best jumping result of declared Rider/horse will be recorded each day.
- \*\*Points will be allocated as follows, 1st to 6th; 1st (10), 2nd (8), 3rd (7), 4th (6), 5th (5), 6th (4).
- \*\* 4 Team Riders combinations results will count each day & aggregate score over the two days will be the result.
- \*\* Deadlines for substitutions: Horse only Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> September by 12 noon.
- \*\*Scores & table will be shared each day on social media & Final Results will be announced Sunday and presentation will take place after the 120cm class on Sunday.
- \*\* Riders must declare what horse they will be riding on the team (no substitutions after 12 noon on Thursday except exceptional circumstances)
